

Digital Assessment in the future – a workshop for institutions in higher education

The Higher education institutions in Bergen, Norway invites you to participate in workshop on digital assessment in higher education on March 7th 2017.

The University of Bergen (UiB), The Western Norway University of Applied Sciences (HVL) and NHH – the Norwegian School of Economics have since 2014 pioneered in implementing digital assessment in Norway, with UiB leading the charge focusing on digitalization of written exams with a bring your own device (BYOD) model.

Presently, UiB has digitalized 61 % of their written school exams and aims to reach 100 % by the end of 2017 using the assessment software Inspira Assessment. HVL and NHH following suit with the assessment software WISEflow.

Adopting the BYOD model to suit the variation between the institutions has allowed for a cross-systems provider collaboration with focus on sharing of experiences and best practices. To further enhance our model and share our knowledge, we invite everyone interested to join us for a workshop in Bergen Norway on March 7th 2017, with the following tentative program:
